4. Report of the Chair

Chair Dave Burnham remarked on the impact of Covid-19 on our operations and the excellent way in which our resident care staff responded. He also addressed the impact of this pandemic on our fundraising capabilities, addressed the steps being taken to cope with the challenge and thanked the many donors, sponsors and community groups that continued to support us. In conclusion, he expressed his appreciation for the deep support given by all volunteers who are the heart of our success in maintaining The Bridge Hospice.

5. Report of the Treasurer

Gerry Hutcheon, Treasurer, reported on the excellent financial results achieved in the past fiscal year. He noted the significant surplus of revenues that were mainly due to two very large donations. As well, he noted that expenses, excepting salaries and resident care wage costs only increased by 1.3%. He described the impact of the completion of the Saint Elizabeth contract and the consequent loss of this revenue in future. This change has resulted in a significant change in our staffing model which will require innovative programs to replace the revenue. In conclusion, he extended appreciation to Brenda Partridge and the many volunteers who assisted him in his work as Treasurer.
